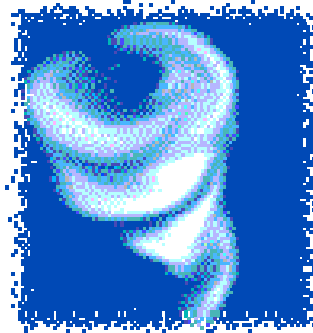

FREE NOAA WEATHER RADIO

1. Are you a resident of the lower seven counties?
2. Do you live in a rural area or town that has no weather siren?
3. Do you wish you could know ahead of time when a severe storm is coming your way?
4. Do you know five people?

If you can say yes to all of the questions above then you qualify for a free NOAA Weather Radio.

To receive a free NOAA radio all you need to do is live in a rural area or town where there is no weather siren, complete the weather radio registration form and agree to call five people if you are alerted to take shelter.

Complete and mail the form on the reverse side to the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program, Shawnee Development Council, Inc., 530 W. Washington Street, P. O. Box 298 Karnak, Illinois, 62956. For more information you may call 618-634-2201.
